

A Place in the Sun for 75 Years

- 1945: 9 acres purchased on Pigeon Lake by Luther Leaguers of Alberta for \$1000
- 1946: Bible camp site dedicated to service of God by Luther Leaguers
- 1947: "Red Barn" first lodge
- 1948: 15.2 acres adjoining parcel for \$1000
- 1948: Kitchen with bedroom built north of "red barn"
- 1951: 5 cabins built (3 for boys, 2 for girls)
- 1951: Dining hall was attached to kitchen
- 1963: First telephone installed
- 1963: Electricity installed
- 1966: 128.9 acres purchased across the road
- 1967-68: New lodge built, \$41 000 with money from Canada's 100th birthday "project 67"
- 1972: Area opened for trailer campers
- 1974: Under auspices of synod, five year funding campaign, coordinating congregational support
- 1975: Original sauna built
- 1977: Camp board formally organized, converted propane to gas
- 1978: Plans made to build lagoon on the farm
- 1979: 28 trailer sites equipped with power and dumping station, equipment shed built, groundskeeper hired
- 1980's: Chell's cabin constructed
- 1988: Camp sold for \$1 to an association of congregations
- 1996: Sauna rebuilt after fire, washroom/shower house installed
- 1999: Quonset donated for picnic area
- 2004: 3 Kabinz for Kidz (washroom in center) replaced aging cabins (sleeps 42)
- 2011: Pioneer shelter built
- 2014: Office trailer moved on site, roof added in 2015
- 2015: Mulhurst celebrates 70th anniversary
- 2018: Lodge expansion(south) and Eden lodge added (sleeps 49)
- 2019: Directors Den(cook's cabin) relocated (south of Kabinz for kidz)
- 2020: Playground & exercise equipment installed, volleyball court moved
- 2020: Ground Broken for East expansion of the Main Lodge.
